All Young Ambassadors are assigned an experienced mentor to support their professional development



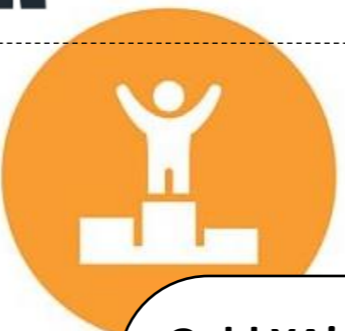
Bronze YA's

- 9 years of age or above
- Able to inspire and influence other young people
- Set up a new sports club at lunchtime



Silver YA's

- 12 years of age or above
- Attendance to monthly coaching clinics
- To setup, promote and run own extracurricular club within your local area with support from Gold YA's or Sports Development Staff.
- Work with Bronze YA's in cluster feeder schools



Gold YA's

- 14 years of age or above
- Experienced Silver YA or have been an outstanding leader in their school or community
- Have independently setup, promoted and delivered extracurricular club within your school or community.
- Working experience of a variety of programmes and initiatives including Tennis, Fitness, Swimming and Cycling



Platinum YA's

- 16 years of age or above
- Excellent communication & leadership skills, and the ability to influence & inspire others
- Outstanding commitment as a Gold YA and to career professional development
- Lead the training and mentoring of Gold, Silver and Bronze Young Ambassadors both locally and city wide
