
Moving Around the Festival

Big Splash 2025 Zones

Splashtonbury at the Riverfront



This is the main festival zone.

There will be fun for families.

You can enjoy arts, crafts and workshops.

There will be live music, circus, dance and street shows.

Areas within this zone are:

Riverfront Theatre and Arts Centre

Shows will happen outside the theatre front doors.

You can stand on the steps at the front of the theatre to watch the shows.

There will be no seating.

There is a ramp to the left of the steps to access the theatre.

Music will be loud in this area.



The Mini-Makers Parade starts at the Riverfront Theatre on Sunday 20 July at 3pm.

It will go around the theatre and along the river.

It will end at the Celebrate Stage.

The route is flat and takes about 30 minutes.

There will be a Samba Band. It will be noisy.



There will be some performances inside the Riverfront Theatre.

These will take place in the **foyer**, opposite the Box Office.

This area may be busy or noisy.

The Terrace Garden

You can get to this garden from the café inside the theatre.

It is on the ground floor and has level access.


Workshops will take place here.

You can sit and relax in this space.

The Art Gallery

It is on the ground floor and has level access.

You can sit down and take part in activities here.

The Studio Theatre

You can get to here from inside the Riverfront Theatre.

It is on the ground floor and has level access.

You can take part in an activity here.

It will be dark and there will be flashing lights.

The Dance Studio

This is on the first floor of the Riverfront Theatre.

You can use stairs or a lift.

Dance workshops will happen here.

There will be some seating.

It will be noisy.

There is natural light and fluorescent lighting in this room.

This room may be used for other activities if it rains.

Basement



You can get to the basement using the lift inside the Riverfront building.

Skate workshops will happen in the basement.

Go to Level -1 to watch the skating.

There is a viewing platform with some seats.

This level is wheelchair accessible.

It can be **noisy** in this area.

Go to **Level -2** if you want to take part in skate lessons.

Be careful when you leave the lift:

- There is a **low beam** above your head.
- Skaters may already be using the space, so watch out for people skating.

There are **no windows**, so no natural light.

The room has **bright fluorescent lights** on the ceiling.

It can be **noisy** in this area.

Chill Space



This is on the **first floor** of the Riverfront Theatre, in the Conference Room.

You can use stairs or a lift to get here.

This is a **quiet space** to take a break.

It can also be used as a prayer room.

Prayer mats are available.

No food, drink or phone calls in this space.

Please keep noise low.

This room has natural light and fluorescent lighting.

Please ask for the lighting to be turn off if it is too bright.

Operasonic presents The Dock Stage

This is a small stage outside the Riverfront Theatre.

There will be sofas and chairs to sit on.

It will be noisy.

Celebrate Stage Zone



You can watch live shows from local groups and artists.

You can walk along Big Splash Boulevard.

There will be games, stalls and fun by the river.

Areas within this zone are:

It goes from the Riverfront Theatre towards Newport Bridge.

There will be stalls, games and workshops.

You can join in or buy things.

There is level access.

There is not much seating.

Celebrate Stage Area

This stage is at the end of the 'Red Wave' area.

Shows will be on a raised outdoor stage.

There will be bench seating.

There is level access.

Music will be loud and it may get busy.

Some shows will have BSL interpretation.

Usk Plaza Zone



This is a **fun and exciting** area with street theatre and circus acts.

You can get your face painted here.

The Information Station is here, where you can ask questions about Big Splash festival.

Areas within this zone are:

Usk Plaza Area

You can get here by **stairs or lift** from John Frost Square (Level 1) to go down to Usk Plaza (Ground Floor).

There is level access from the river side.



This is a small show space near the restaurants on the ground floor of Friar's Walk.

There is a small stage and fake grass to sit on.

Some shows will be on a raised stage.

Some shows will happen on the floor in front of the stage.

There are no chairs here.

It will be noisy here.

All shows are safe, but some may include fire or performers doing tricks high up.

These might be upsetting for some people.

The Information Station

The Information Station is on the ground floor of Friar's Walk, next to Usk Plaza.

You can find the Information Station under the Newport Live gazebos.

The Newport Live gazebos.are directly **outside a** restaurant called Bistro Pierre.





Friendly staff will be here to help you.

They will be able to answer questions about the festival.

Face painting is here too.

It is popular and there may be queues.

It may be noisy from nearby shows.

Newport Now Creative Quarter



This zone shows local art and culture.

You can visit Gallery 57, The Place and Waterstones.

There will be exhibitions, shows and workshops.

There will be surprise pop-up shows and roaming acts.


Gallery 57 can be found on Upper Dock Street.


It is two doors to the left of the Mercure Hotel.
